G. Player Registrations: Neil Anderson (AHJSA Registrar) will organise a meeting of all club registrars on Monday February 7th at Bridgewater. He will discuss the information he requires and the process he would like followed for season 2011. Neil will forward spreadsheets to be completed by registrars. All registrations need to be finalised by March 25th.

H. Newspaper Advertisement: The AHJSA will put an advertisement in the Courier with details and contact numbers and registration dates for all clubs.

I. Police Checks: It is now law that all coaches and team managers and any club official who has direct contact with players to submit a police check for clearance. These checks are free if organised through the AHJSA (voluntary organisation). Form and procedure is on website. Enter details, print off form then forward to Nick Papavasiliou (Chair).

7. GENERAL BUSINESS:

Rule Changes – there will be an amendment to Rule 8F re players playing outside the team they were originally registered for. This will be discussed fully next meeting when the new rule has been properly worded.

Bad Weather Policy Protocol – Assoc needs a list of club contacts who can be contacted on Saturday mornings when games have been cancelled due to bad weather.
General discussion re protocol for abandoned matches – procedures to be followed are on website.

Pitch Sizes – all details on website

Paul Rees - (Referees Branch) – raised issue re throw ins – will allow rethrow in non-competitive age groups.
Team Stewards Role – vests and guidelines to be distributed before start of season.
Need to amend ground stewards rules

Under 19 and Senior Women Competition –
Meeting will be held next Monday January 24th 7.30pm at Bridgewater. Each club need to send at least one representative if this competition is to commence this season.

Law Change on Liability on Goals – all goals are required to be pegged down – needs to be put on game rules.

Kelly Bucco – enquired as to the “come’n’try” sessions the Association was going to set up (discussed at previous meeting). James Kerr discussed the Cottees 5-a-side sessions that will be held at some primary schools but as yet nothing officially organised by AHJSA.
We need to promote more grass roots soccer related to National Curriculum. May need to be done by clubs individually. James will try to organise after Assoc Coaches Meeting.

Referees Branch – Paul discussed numbers for season 2011 – currently low but no panic yet as numbers will increase as season approaches.
No law changes by FIFA.

Skins - discussion re skins for season 2011.

Motion by James Kerr –

“Skins shorts can be worn in Competitive age groups without penalty – only to be changed if obvious clash with opponents colours. Long Sleeve undergarments are to be same colour as primary colour of strip.

Seconded Chris Marston

Motion carried.

Referee Training Courses – Level 5 - mid year recruitment for following year.

Inspection Course – for mentoring

Trial games – referees can be allocated – contact Programmer.

Coaching Courses – Junior and Senior Licences – possibly late March/April – James will advise.
